


## Peter's Epistles Series #2

2. What does Peter suggest is a Christian's identity?


3. Rewrite/paraphrase 1 Peter 1:3-5 (from any translation) in your own words. Take turns to share your version of the verse with one another.



- 4. How does knowing and having faith in Jesus Christ produce joy during challenging times in your life? (1 Peter 1:6-7)
- 5. What do Old Testament prophets have to say about the coming of Jesus Christ? (1 Peter 1:10, e.g. Deuteronomy 18:15-16, Isaiah 7:14, Jeremiah 23:5-6, etc.)
- 6. Do you agree that trials can strengthen your faith? Why or why not?
