- 2. Read 1 Peter 2:12 and Matthew 5:16. How can we ensure that both our actions and words effectively convey the message of the gospel, in a world that doubts the authenticity of our Christian faith?
- 3. Reflecting on the illustration of the two wolves symbolizing good and evil within us, what daily practices can we adopt to empower the victory of the good wolf over the bad wolf?
- 4. How can we navigate circumstances where government policies conflict with God's principles, while maintaining the principle of submission?
- 5. Consider submission in different areas of life such as at work, home. How can Christians maintain a balanced approach that respects authority while standing firm for God's truth and justice in times of moral conflict?
